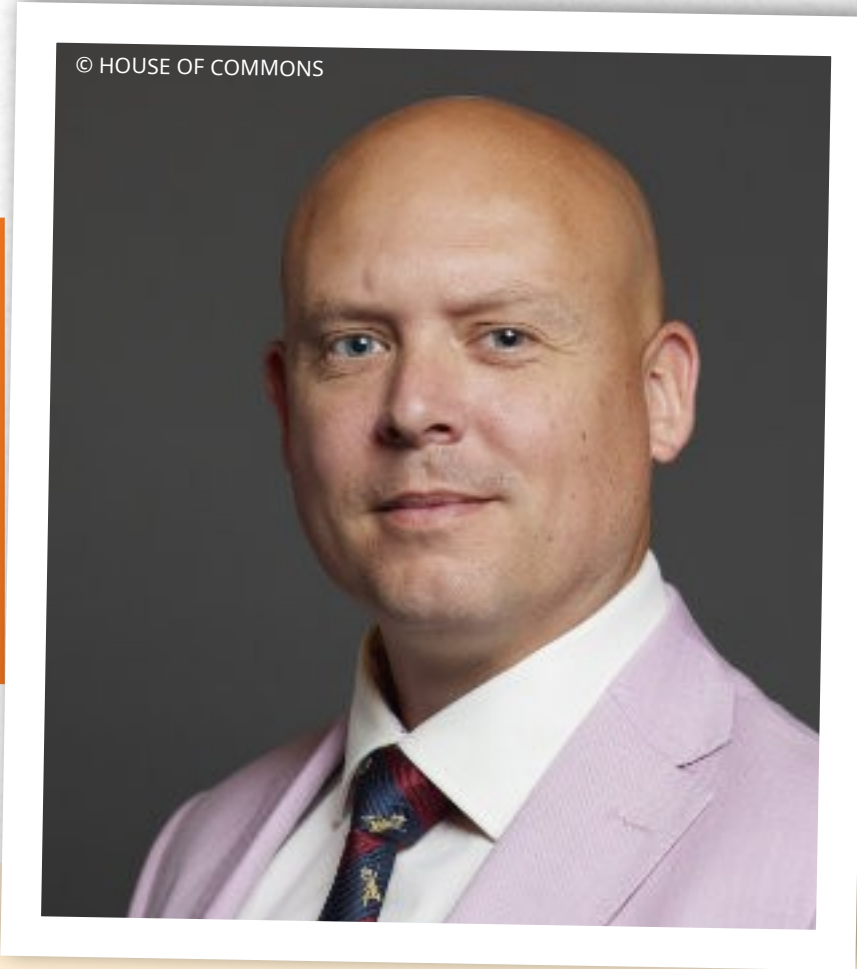

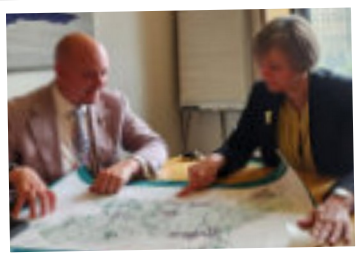

A year of campaigning and delivering for people across Tewkesbury and our part of Gloucestershire...



Fighting for our education services:



Alongside several visits to local schools and academies, Cameron has fought for our education system in Westminster.

He has fought for SEND provisions to be improved, and called for a review into the National Funding Formula to ensure our schools receive fair, adequate funding to support the next generation.

Standing up for our NHS:



Pressure on our NHS and care system means waiting times keep rising for our essential services.

Cameron is asking the Government to exclude GP staff from National Insurance hikes to ensure we can be treated when we need it. He has met with NHS staff and carers to discuss the effects of local strikes and the impact on patients.

Delivering more jobs:



Cameron is supporting local apprenticeships to up-skill our next generation.

Improving our local train services:



Ashchurch Railway Station is long overdue significant work to improve its services.

Cameron has campaigned and collaborated with Midlands Rail Project which has now been granted funding by the government. He is pleased to announce services have now doubled at Ashchurch Station, a welcome development.

Tackling local flooding:



Cameron is on the Environmental Audit Committee, and launched an inquiry into improving flood resilience in England.

Fighting for a new motorway junction:

Cameron has been working with ministers in Westminster to open a new junction on the M5.

This junction is essential to relieve congestion and improve logistical routes. The opening of the Cotswolds Designer Outlet has already increased local traffic and congestion, as will other planned local development in the near future.



Returning local services:



Cameron worked to secure Winchcombe a new Post Office after two years without the service.

Winning for pensioners:



Cameron successfully campaigned for the Winter Fuel Allowance to be reinstated for our pensioners.

Fighting for our carers:



Cameron is supporting carers across the constituency, including Gloucestershire Young Carers.

Cameron has a visible presence on Church Street in Tewkesbury and works across the whole constituency.
